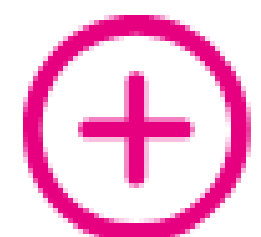

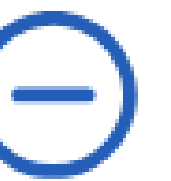

CLEARING PLUS

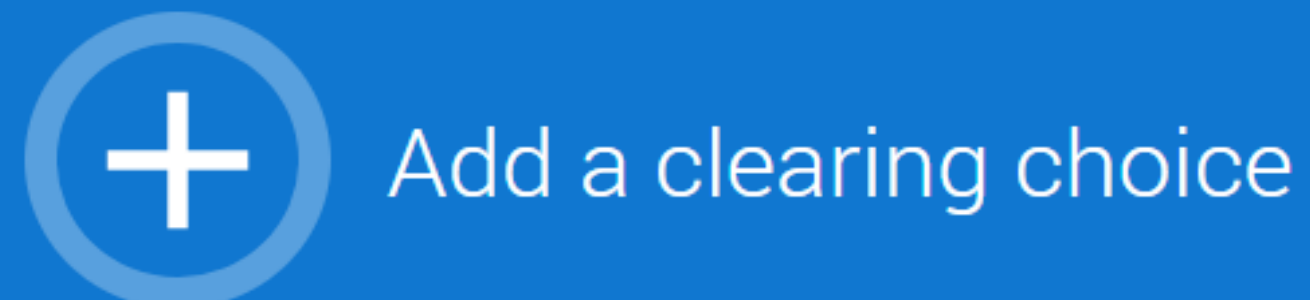

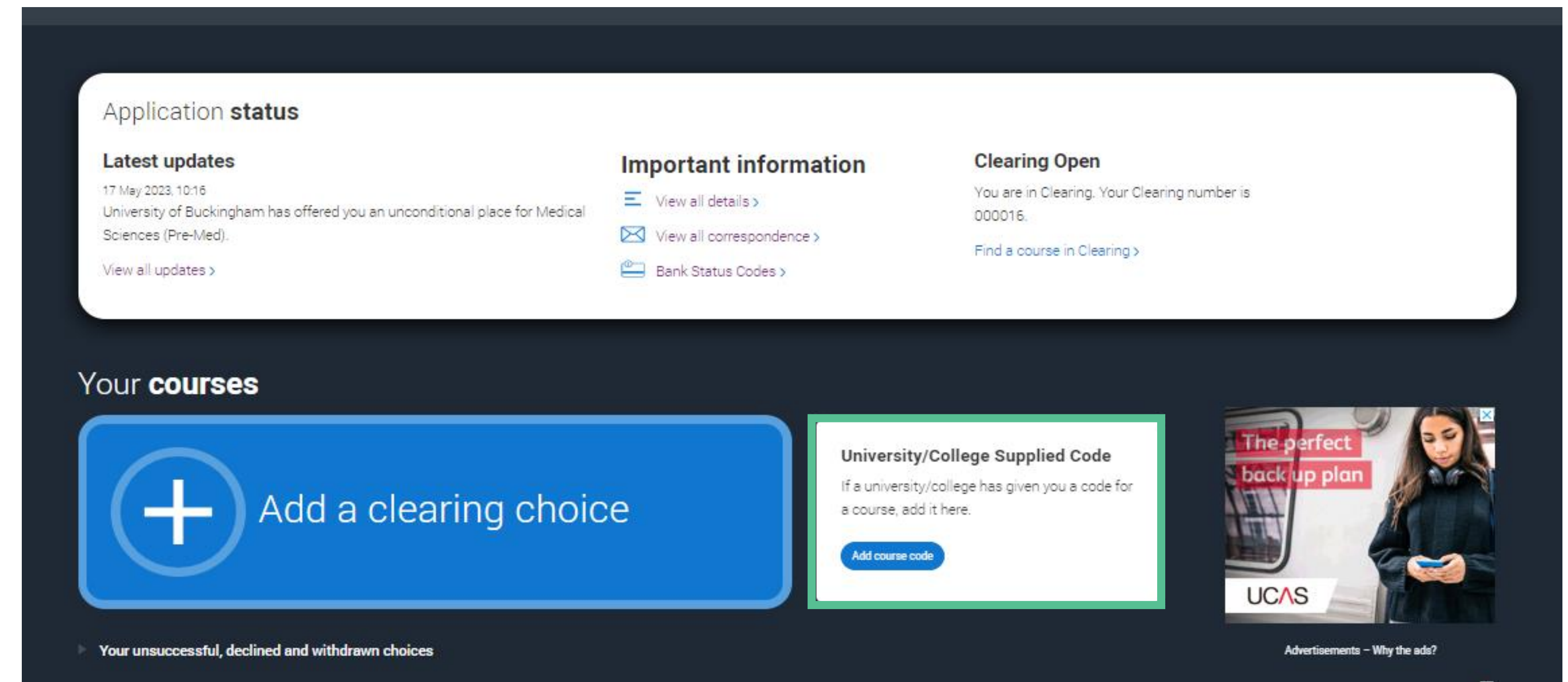
