Timings of when you are expected to attend MS Teams virtual lessons

P2	1040-1145 (5 mins log-on time – teacher starts lesson 1045)	60m

P3	1200-1305 (5 mins log-on time – teacher starts lesson 1205)	60m

P4	1330-1435 (5 mins log-on time – teacher starts lesson 1335)	60m

What will this look like?

If you have gone into your Team, you will be able to join the meeting by
pressing the join button. From that point you will get instructions from your
teacher about what to do next.



What is a virtual lesson?

- This means that you need to be in your Team (for the normal lesson you are meant to have on that day at that particular time) and the Teacher should have a Live 'meeting' that you are expected to join (as shown on previous slide). They will give everyone 5 minutes at the very start of the lesson to give time for all students to join.
- After this 5 minutes, the teacher should start and will typically deliver a 10-15 minute lesson chunk (using a PowerPoint or alternative) before then giving you a task to do (this is likely to be an MS Teams assignment).
- Your teacher will tell you how to contact them to ask any questions

What else do I need to know?

- Remember that this is new to everyone and you need to be patient, especially for the first few days.
- If your teacher is not there for the 'Live' part of the session then try not to worry.
- It should at least be the case that they have left some work within your Team to complete.
- This may not always be an assignment (but this is the general idea)
- Unless this is an extended task (that spans more than one lesson) then tasks ideally should be designed to be completed in the rest of the lesson time (so, about half an hour)
