		Medium	To minimise touchpoints doors will be kept open, using doorstops, where possible. In the case of fire doors, automatic closing attachments will be fitted. Only the main doors in reception will be kept closed using the usual entrance system.	Low
		Medium	Toilets will be cleaned after each session. Students will be escorted to toilets during lessons. During breaks toilet areas will be supervised. Where multiple cubicles exist, only a limited number will be available at one time to aid with cleaning rota	Low
Social distancing within class rooms and corridors and playground areas.	Due to the width of the corridors social distancing of 2m is not possible. High	 The SIMS alert system will be used. A member of the office staff will come in PPE to escort the student to the isolation area (by student reception). Parent/carer will be contacted and asked to collect as soon as possible (this is a condition of students being allowed into school). In an emergency we will call 999. A test will be organised using the fast track testing protocol. Following this, PHE guidelines will be followed (details here) 	Medium
A student has an injury or falls ill with non COVID-19 symptoms	Close contact required within the 2m recommended social distance.	High	Each room will have a sealed pack of PPE available. The main office will be contacted for assistance. If appropriate, staff will put on PPE to support the student until assistance arrives. Following this, the standard school injury protocol will be followed.	Low
Work undertaken in	Risk of cross contamination with COVID-19 virus on paper or equipment	Medium	Students will be asked to bring all books and equipment with them. No equipment or books will be lent out.	Low
classrooms	Work handed in by students may contain traces of COVID-19 virus.	Medium	If possible, work will be submitted electronically. If any work is handed in, it will be left for at least 24 hours before being marked. After collection, hands must be washed or hand sanitiser used.	Low
	Students sharing equipment or resources	Medium	There will be no sharing of equipment or resources under any circumstances	Low
Return of significant numbers of students at one time	When the school is expecting a significant numbers of students in at a time.	Medium	Where significant numbers are expected we will plan for staggered starts and breaks to ensure that supervision is manageable and social distancing possible.	Low
Fire Procedures	When following a standard fire evacuation, social distancing will not be possible	Medium	An addendum to the fire evacuation procedures has been written to allow for social distancing. Posters in all rooms.	Low

A family returns from abroad	Potential risk of family being exposed to COVID-19 virus and being asymptomatic.	Medium	All families retuning from travel abroad will self-isolate for 14 days as per the current government guidance.	Low
A student using public transport or taxi to come to school	Risk of pupil having prolonged exposure to the virus.	High	Parents/carers should discuss with their children about the safe use of public transport. Guidance can be found <u>here</u> . All students will follow hygiene protocols when they arrive at school	Low
Queries from parents	Potential risk of office staff being exposed to multiple adults and the virus.	High	Any queries from parents/carers must be done through 'phone or email.	Low

General hygiene guidance from Public Health England

- frequently wash your hands with soap and water for 20 seconds and dry thoroughly. Review the <u>guidance on</u> <u>hand cleaning</u>
- clean their hands on arrival at school, before and after eating, and after sneezing or coughing
- where hand washing is not available use gel hand sanitiser
- you are encouraged not to touch your mouth, eyes and nose
- use a tissue or elbow to cough or sneeze and use bins for tissue waste ('catch it, bin it, kill it')
- there is no need for anything other than normal personal hygiene and washing of clothes following a day in an educational setting
