Virtual Open Days

Due to the unprecedented times that the UK is challenged with, universities have been forced to host virtual open days. Following government guidance due to the COVID-19 outbreak, universities are unable to host open days because of the restrictions on group gatherings.

Open days are important as they give you, as a potential student, the opportunity to get a real feel about your prospective place of study.

What will happen during a virtual open day?

A virtual open day means you'll be able to do this all online. You'll learn about the course you've applied to or thinking of applying to, all the development opportunities that are provided at the university and how you can build your professional skills. A virtual open day will also enable you to meet the academic team and ask any questions you have about the course requirements and modules.

Should I attend a virtual open day?

Absolutely! Think of it as a try before you buy process. This is an ideal way for you to find out more about the university, including their campus, course content, key central facilities and the range of accommodation offered.
