Geography Terms

High Pressure	Air pressure between 1020 and 1040 millibars
Low pressure	Air pressure between 970 and 990 millibars
Temperature range	The difference between maximum and minimum temperature
Anticyclone	A high pressure system
Total annual rainfall	The total amount rainfall for the year
Maritime climate	The climate conditions of land close to the sea
Prevailing wind	The direction in which the wind most often blows
Depression	A low pressure system
Cyclone	An intense low pressure area
Urban Heat Island	When a city has temperatures that are warmer than the surrounding rural areas


