

Apprenticeship Levels:



Level 6 & 7 (Higher Degree Apprenticeships)

*Equivalent to a full degree (6) or a Masters Degree (7)
Currently around 200 standards*

Level 4 & 5 (Higher Apprenticeships)

*Equivalent to foundation degree level
Currently around 180 standards*

Level 3 (Advanced Apprenticeship)

*Equivalent to 2 A-levels
Currently around 280 standards*

Level 2 (Intermediate Apprenticeship)

*Equivalent to 5 GCSE's 4 – 9
Currently around 170 standards*



- ☑ **Do your research** – How can I get into my preferred industry? What qualifications/ experience will I need?
- ☑ **Attend career events** (virtual or in person). Set up a LinkedIn profile.
- ☑ Find local employers and approach to request some **work experience**.
- ☑ [Build your CV](#) and cover letter for job applications.
- ☑ Consider doing a **Pre-apprenticeship programme** or **traineeship**
- ☑ Register on [National Apprenticeship Service gov.uk](#) for current apprenticeship opportunities.
