What should students be doing in the ISA for Geography (AQA)?

- Revisiting class notes:
 - Consolidate your notes from class into a revision tool that suits you- e.g. mind maps, tables, concept maps, flashcards.
 - Revisit key terms and ensure you understand their meanings.
 - Use the White text books to add notes to your lesson information

Past exam papers:

- Use the AQA Geography A level page to find past papers, mark schemes and examiners reports. Attempt to answer questions and mark yours or a peer using the mark scheme. By the end of Year 13 you should have attempted every paper available to you.

Video explainers:

- Tutor2u is excellent for video explainers of topics, all available on YouTube as well as the Tutor2u website.

Keeping up to date with news stories:

- There are so many current events happening that can supplement your class case studies. E.g the LA wildfires. Research BBC news and other news outlets to gather up to date information.
- Read Geography Review magazine- it is designed for A level Geographers and can be accessed in S1- please return after use.
